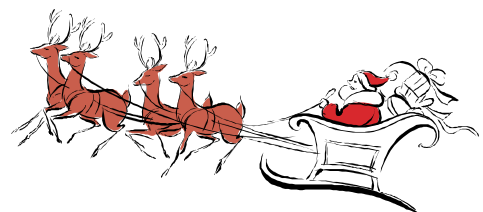

2. There will be a mandatory pre-parade meeting, especially important for new entrants. All float applicants must send a representative as there are several new changes this year. **November 18th—7pm , Lion's Community Centre, 157 Elgin Street East, Cobourg**
3. All bands must report to CDCI East for marshalling.
4. All dignitaries must report to CDCI East for marshalling.
5. CDCI East will be open for use by parade participants this year.
6. Please note that there is no overall theme for the parade. Theme is to be selected by the entrant.
7. Please ensure that the float captain reads and signs the application before submission. Unsigned and/or late parade applications will not be accepted.
